REPORT ON EDUCATION ENROLLMENT FOR CHILDREN INFECTED/AFFECTED BY HIV/AIDS IN QUANGNAM PROVINCE- VIETNAM

The project named “Education enrollment for children infected/affected by HIV/AIDS in Quang Nam province - Vietnam” has been implementing in Quang Nam province with the cooperation between VNHIP and Quangnam Center for Disease Control (Quangnam CDC).

This project has provided the awareness-raising activities, scholarship, life skill training courses and necessary financial support for children, families and communities to enable the children receiving inclusive education and integrating into their family as well as their community.

With HULZA Foundation timely support, VNHIP cooperated with Quangnam CDC to support households directly by providing needed things for them.

We have planned to support up 35 children infected/affected by HIV/AIDS. We collaborated with Quangnam CDC to directly provide necessary financial aid for children by providing 30 scholarships and 05 scholarship to university students for the new school year 2022-2023 in this autumn to enable them to be enrolled in inclusive education, to integrate into their families as well as into their communities. Thereby, we do hope that it will be a strong motivation for all children and their caretakers to overcome all difficulties of 2022. Besides that, the awareness-raising activities such as: Outdoor trip, Mid-Autumn festival were held in August and September 2022

Started from 2018, this long term project continued to receive the funding from the HULZA Foundation in 2022. Most of funding was transferred by VNHIP to local partners for them to directly implement all activities of project.

I.Children International's Day (30 children infected/affected with HIV/AIDS and their caregivers)

On the occasion of Children International Day, VNHIP together with the Quangnam CDC held an event for 30 children including 14 children living with HIV/AIDS and 16 children affected by HIV/AIDS and their caregivers in Quangnam province. In this event, many activities were carried out and all children and their caregivers engaged actively and enjoyed completely. In addition, gifts were also offered to all children





Furthermore, VNHIP together with The Quangnam CDC organized outdoor activities for 40 HIV infected/affected children and caregivers in Quangnam province. The children was very excited with games and gifts.

II. The advance training course on life-skill development for the HIV infected/affected children in Quang Nam province, Vietnam

Following previous successful life skill development training sessions, VNHIP recently organized more training for disadvantaged children in Quang Nam. 11 topics were covered: Self-worth awareness skills

Skills to nurture dream; Skills on prevention of child abused and how to defend; Creative thinking skills; Skills to seek support; Presentation skills; Teamwork skill; Communication skills; Conflict resolution skills; Problem-solving, Decision-making and choice skills; Skills to build and develop positive habits

1. Self-worth awareness skills

- Students realize that they are valuable people, so they should respect and love themselves.
- Help students see their inner values properly and be able to bounce back in their challenged times

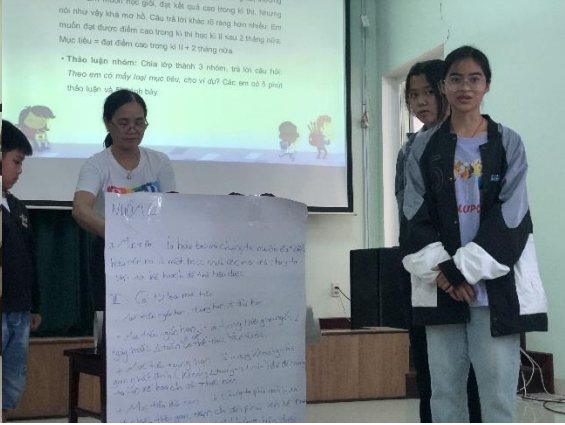




2. Skills to nurture dream

- Students understand the concept of goal setting.
- Know the principles and methods for practicing goal setting skills.





3. Creative thinking skills

- Help students to brainstorm and thinking outside the box





4. Presentation skill

- Help them confidently present in front of the crowd.
- Have the mindset of a great presenter.
- Use body language fluently when presenting: flexible hands, observing eyes...

- The presentation has a clear structure: engaging introduction, committed conclusion...



5. Communication skill

- Know some basic requirements when communicating with people around.
- Understand some standards of behavior and style when communicating.
- Apply communication requirements and behaviors to cultivate friendships and positive relationships with people around.



6. Child abused and how to defend it

- Children can recognize forms of abuse and situations of being abused

- Children know how to protect/defend themselves when being abused.



7. Seeking for help skill

- Children know the importance and requirements of helping and seeking help from others.
- Children understand some methods of seeking support when facing difficulties.
- Children know how to apply some requirements, ways to seek support and help from people around





8. Teamwork skill

- Children are aware of what group work is and understand the benefits of group work.
- Help children practice teamwork skills.
- Children know how to listen, share, support, and coordinate with each other to effectively perform the group's work.





9. Conflict resolution skill

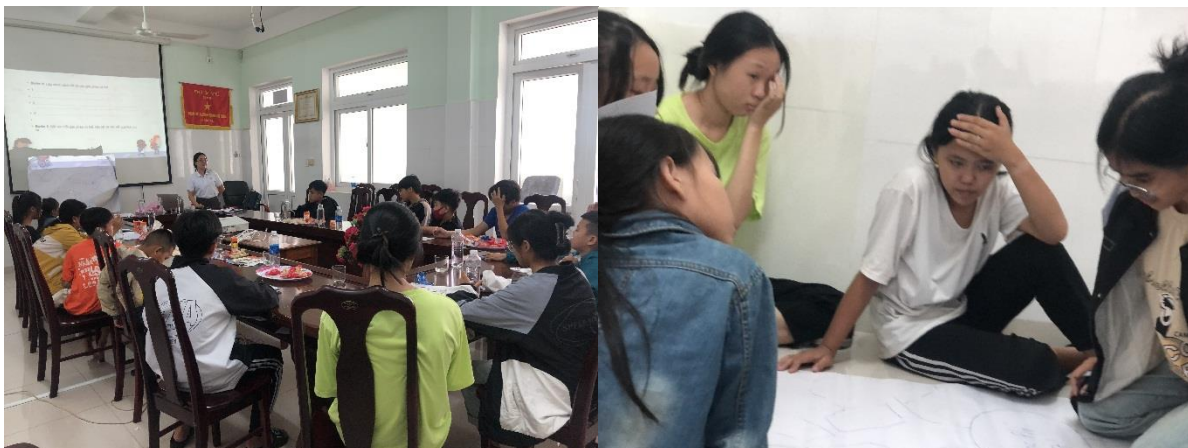
- Children are aware of the conflicts arising in life and the causes of those conflicts.
- Children perceive the need for positive conflict resolution.
- Children know how to deal with conflicts wisely.





10. Problem solution, decision making and choices

- Children understand the concept of problems and problem solving.
- Children know the steps of problem solving.
- Children know what responsible decision-making is like.
- Children know the steps to make a correct decision
- Children know how to apply it to life to make right





11. Skill to building and developing positive habits

- Help children to be conscious in building positive habits
- Forming and training positive habits for children.





III. Scholarship

Based on the contract signed, the Quangnam CDC delivered in-cash scholarship to 30 children infected/affected by HIV/AIDS. Similarly, 05 university students who infected with HIV/AIDS received in-cash scholarship. These supports helped HIV/AIDS children from poor families having opportunity to continue their study and pursue their dream



IV. Mid-Autumn festival event

The Mid-Autumn Festival (MAF) which is known as “Tet Trung Thu” in Vietnam is one of the biggest holidays and it traditionally held on the 15th day of the Lunar August

In this event, The Vietnam Health Improvement Project (VNHIP), together with The Quangnam Center For Disease Control, organized outdoor activities for 35 HIV infected/affected children in Quangnam province, Vietnam. The HIV infected/affected children and their caregivers came to this event. Combined with some innovative games, the children was very excited with other games and crazily happy when receiving gifts.
